Dear Physician:

For a prefabricated AFO (ankle-foot-orthosis) to be covered by Medicare, all applicable Medicare statutory and regulatory requirements must be met. Medicare requires a physical evaluation of the patient, and the **following bullet points must be included in the <u>physician's chart note.</u>** (Medicare does not consider a letter part of the medical record). Please fax any Medicare compliant chart notes to our office.

The physician must document AND DISCUSS the following:

- 1. Patient is ambulatory (or, if not currently ambulatory, the plan to progress the patient to ambulation); **and**
- 2. Patient has a weakness or deformity of the foot and ankle; and
- 3. Patient requires stabilization of the foot and ankle for medical reasons; and
- 4. Patient has the potential to benefit functionally from the use of an AFO
